ICS Online Course Options Beginning April 2026 and July 2026

ICS winter courses are set to begin the week of April 20, 2026. Educators affiliated with Vocate are encouraged to explore these online course offerings available during the upcoming summer term to help meet CSTC requirements:

Lead From Where You Are (3 credit hours) provides understanding and practice in how to diagnose and address the toughest problems experienced by organizations. Students will identify the leadership they are able to contribute to addressing these problems from where they are in their organizations. (CSTC 2 or 4; 132504/260003)

Called to Teach: Formation and Learning (3 credit hours) is a course that provides educators with a vocational vision of Christian educational innovation and leadership. It is intended to guide educators on an inner journey as they begin cultivating personal competency in critical and constructive reflection on their professional practice. (CSTC 4; 260001)

What is Christian About Christian Education: Reformational Philosophy (3 credit hours) will offer you an opportunity to reflect on what it means to teach or educate “Christianly.” It will situate a Reformational understanding of Christian education. The goal is to give you time, space, and resources to develop a clearer understanding of how faith impacts education in general, and how your faith shapes what you do as an educator more specifically. (CSTC 2; 1107A /2107AC)

Structure of Courses

All of the above online courses begin the week of April 20, 2026, and run for 10 weeks with a break during the month of July and then three additional days during the first or second week of August.

This summer we are offering an Intensive Course that runs between July 13 - August 14:

Christian Deeper Learning: From Wonder to Inquiry to Practice (3 credit hours) seeks to help Christian educators develop deeper learning. We will consider what it means to be image-bearers of God called to care for our neighbours and to be engaged in real work that is part of God’s story. Together we will examine the importance of global citizenship as a form of deeper learning and the impact it has on developing a caring and just world. (Intensive Course) (CSTC 3; 260004)

Registering for Courses

ICS courses cost \$1,525 CAD (registration fee included).

A \$500 grant is available to teachers who require financial assistance.
